# **Explanation**

Everyday, children's names are on READY TO LEARN on the Behaviour Ladder. This means every day is a new start.

Children will be able to move up the Ladder when they are working well. This could be for work they have produced in any of their lessons. Children are also noticed for their positive learning behaviours, listening skills, working well as part of team and for the effort they put into their learning. They will be moved up one step at a time.

Moving up the ladder means that they can achieve:



- Extra Dojo points
- Postcard Home
- Green Card / Sticker /Positive discussion with the Headteacher
- Special Reward (Pop and Choc with the Headteacher).



Equally, if children make the wrong choices, do not follow instructions, break the rules they will move down the Ladder.

Children will be given a chance to turn their behaviour round but if they continue to exhibit negative behaviours they will be:

- Moved to Stop and Think (about their behaviour)
- Yellow Card 5 minutes lost from their break or lunch break to work with Mr Bartlett.
- Red Card 15 mins from lunch break to catch up on work missed with Mrs

Again, this is one step at a time, down the Ladder. Children at any point can turn their behaviour round and move back up the Ladder.

If a child is physical with another child of member of staff (pushing, hitting, kicking etc). They will move straight to a Red Card.

If a child receives 3 Red Cards in a half term, parents will be asked to come into school to discuss their child's behaviour.

#### **Lates and Absences**

- The school gates open at 8.45am and close at 9am.
- ❖ We kindly ask that any parents are off-site by 9am, as this is when the final register must be taken.
- If you arrive after the school gate has closed, please sign in at the front office.
- If your child is ill and not going to be in school, please can you ensure that you phone the school stating the reason that you child will not be school before 9am.

The above is to ensure all safeguarding procedures are adhered to. Thank you so much for your support.
